Pilgrim Statue of the Immaculate Heart of Our Lady of Fatima from the World Apostolate of Fatima

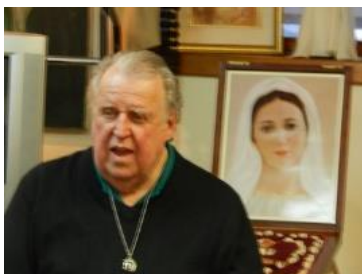
