HEAVEN CALLS—IS YOUR RINGER ON?

Blessing and prayers to all our friends, supporters and newsletter subscribers of the Central NY Marian Center.

As we enter the new liturgical season of Ordinary Time, do our hearts ring out with great love for the **Sacred Heart of Jesus and Corpus Christi**as we celebrate their feast days?

The rhythm of the liturgical seasons reflects His rhythm of life, with its celebrations of anniversaries and its seasons of quiet growth and maturing.

The term "Ordinary Time" means" not seasonal." Ordinary Time is that part of the Liturgical Year that lies outside the seasons of Lent-Easter and Advent. Christmas. In Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the mystery of Christ not in one specific aspect but in all its aspects. The readings during the liturgies of Ordinary Time help to instruct us on how to live out our Christian faith in our daily lives.

In vestments usually green, the color of hope and growth, the Church counts the thirty-three or thirty-four

Sundays of Ordinary Time, inviting her children to meditate upon the whole mystery of **Christ** - his life, miracles and teachings - in the light of his Resurrection.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart June 3, 2017

(Properly the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus) is a solemnity in the liturgical calendar of the Roman Catholic Church. It falls 19 days after the Pentecost, on a Friday.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus came into the Catholic faith through a Catholic sister known as **Saint Margaret** Mary Alacoque (1647-1690). At the age of 24, Margaret Mary entered the Visitation convent at Paray-le-Monial in France. She began to have visions of Our Lord and on December 27, 1673, on the Feast of St. John. Jesus told her that she was to become his instrument in spreading devotion to His Sacred Heart. While kneeling before the Blessed Sacrament, Our Lord appeared to her and invited her to "rest a long time on His Divine Breast." Jesus revealed to her the marvels of the love that His Sacred Heart had for mankind.

The fourth apparition, which probably took place on 16 June 1675, was the most important. Again it happened as Margaret Mary was praying before the Blessed Sacrament, when He again showed her a representation of His heart, further complaining of the ingratitude and coldness of mankind towards Him, and particularly when this was the case with those specially consecrated to Him.

To make up for this He asked that the first Friday after the feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for the "Body of Christ"), should be dedicated as a feast in honor of His Sacred Heart, when people should receive Holy Communion in reparation.

The "Great promise" associated with this devotion applied to those who went to Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays: "I promise you, in the excess of the mercy of My Heart, that It's all-powerful love will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the first Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under My displeasure nor without receiving

the Sacraments, My Divine Heart becoming their assured refuge at that last hour.

Only the **Heart of Christ** who knows the depths of His **Father's** love could reveal to us the abyss of his mercy in so simple and beautiful a way. (**CC P:1439**)

Feast of Corpus Christi June 18, 2017

The Feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for Body of Christ) is a Latin Rite liturgical solemnity celebrating the reality of the Body and blood of Jesus Christ Son of God in the Eucharist. It emphasizes the joy of the institution of the Eucharist. The latter had previously been observed only on Maundy Thursday, in the somber atmosphere leading to Good Friday.

The feast is liturgically celebrated on the Thursday after **Trinity Sunday** or, "where the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is not a holy day of obligation, it is assigned to the Sunday after the **Most Holy Trinity** as its proper day". It was reported in 2017, however, that **Pope Francis** had moved the feast from Thursday to the following Sunday, when it is celebrated in Italy.

Medjugorje Apparitions

After 5 years of investigation Vatican commission concludes "Early Medjugorje apparitions were real."

Like with Fatima, responsibility for determining an apparition's veracity lies with the local bishop, according to the norms established by the **Vatican Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith.**

The commission that now-retired **Pope Benedict XVI** established to study the alleged apparitions of Mary at Medjugorje, Bosnia-Herzegovina, reportedly voted overwhelmingly to recognize as supernatural the first seven.

The apparitions of **Medjugorje** began on June 24, 1981, when the Virgin Mary appeared to six Croatian children on a rural hillside. As in the apparitions of **Fatima, Portugal,** perhaps the most

popular of all Marian apparitions, the Virgin comes with the self-proclaimed title, "Queen of Peace." On occasion she appears escorted by angels. At other times, she carries the infant **Jesus** in her arms. Her signature sign, however, is the crown of twelve stars she wears around her head, much like the scriptural woman from the **Book of Revelation**.

Marian apparitions are certainly not a new phenomenon. For centuries, the Virgin Mary has been reported to appear and speak to seers around the world, often in the most remote places. Reports of heavenly visitations in modern times, in fact, are occurring at an unprecedented rate. Yet, there is an importance to the **Medjugorje** phenomenon that merits special attention!!!
