Fatima Centennial Plenary Indulgence Pope Francis has granted three opportunities to obtain a plenary indulgence for the centennial of Fatima, one of which can be obtained by participating in the 13th day events this year at the National Blue Army Shrine. The Shrine, located in Washington, N.J., is dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima. This year they celebrate the Centennial of the Blessed Virgin Mary's apparitions to three shepherd children, Lucia dos Santos, 10 years old, and her younger cousins, Francisco and Jacinta Marto, 9 and 7, respectively. Our Lady appeared to the children six times from May through October.

Bus pickup from two locations: **7am** – Wegmans, 3955 State Rte. 31 (near Great Northern Mall) and **7:15am** – Exit 6 off Rte. 481, Thruway Commuter Park and Ride. **Please arrive 20 minutes before scheduled departure.** 9am - PA Welcome Center rest area, 11am - arrive at the Shrine. We follow the schedule below and leave at 4:15 for our return home. \$60 includes bus transportation and breakfast snacks/juice. BYO coffee. Available but not included in the cost: Driver gratuity; Shrine donations; lunch - at the Shrine or byo; dinner – 6pm on our way home, Bingham's Restaurant (<http://www.binghamsrestaurant.com/>). Final rest stop at the NYS Welcome Center.
